Painted wood doors are as popular as ever. We use a 14-step, furniture-finishing process for beauty and durability topped off with either Standard or Low Sheen. You can stop there, or you can layer in hand-applied specialty techniques for an even richer, unique look.

Standard Paint Colors





Backs of doors are painted, but not glazed or distressed.

Primed, painted wood is randomly sanded to reveal bare edges and high points, then sealed with a clear top coat. Add Glaze if available (no Linen, please). Always with Low Sheen.



Aged Painted or stained wood is randomly dented with special tools to cause stress cracks, and sealed with a clear top coat.

THERMOFOIL CABINETRY

Thermofoils, while very durable, can be damaged by excessive heat. Properly-installed Heat Shields protect cabinets adjacent to ovens, ranges and dishwashers. As a precaution, open doors and drawers away from an oven during high-temperature, selfcleaning cycles. Also, pull countertop appliances, such as toasters, ovens, grills, or coffee makers, out from under the cabinetry before use. Damage caused by excessive heat is not

REPAIR KIT

Small nicks and scratches that occur during daily use can be repaired using the products in the Touch-up Kit. Follow all instructions and keep all products out of reach of children.

MARKER: Capillary markers are ready to use, just remove the cap. Valve Markers require shaking to mix the contents. Depress the valve to start the flow, careful not to over-flood the felt tip.

FILL STICK: Fill damages with the stick and gently remove excess material by rubbing with a clean, dry, lint-free cloth.
